Dear Parents,

In addition to celebrating special days and holidays during the course of the year, we also celebrate each child's birthday.

We will celebrate your child's birthday on the day it occurs unless it falls on a weekend or holiday, in which case we celebrate it as close as possible to the actual day.

Summer birthdays will be celebrated as "half birthdays." If a child's birthday is in July and s/he will be 9, we will celebrate his/her 8½ birthday in January. This way each child will have a special day during the school year. So, please calculate your child's "half birthday" with him/her and mark your calendars.
